Budget: Howard Wood summarized the 2007 year-end summary which shows the investment accounts and the actual expense for the year. He also summarized the 2008 proposed budget and the projected revenue. Howard Wood said that the projected revenue figures are just estimates and said that the only major change to the proposed budget was proposed to change the reimbursement of \$2.50 per plate for the hosting department on the quarterly dinners up to \$7.50 per plate for members who attend. This will help the hosting departments offset the dinner cost since the maximum charge for the dinner is \$10. The Association needs to support the departments that are hosting the dinners, we want them to break even and not lose money. Discussion was then held if the death benefit should be raised. This topic was brought up several times and the benefit should not be raise because the majority of the membership is in the top risk category. Research to be made and paperwork presented showing chart by age group of the membership. A motion was made by Ron Rice to accept the budget as submitted. The motion was seconded by Freddie Abruzzini and unanimously carried.
